Special NDIS Pricing Arrangements

The NDIA uses the Modified Monash Model (MMM) to determine regional, remote and very remote areas using a scale based on population size and locality (see table below).

Further details on the MMM can be found on the Department of Health's DoctorConnect website, which contains a resource to look up the MMM area for particular locations¹.

Participants located in MMM4 and MMM5 areas are classified as 'Regional', MMM6 as 'Remote', and MMM7 as 'Very Remote'. In general, price limits are 40% higher in remote areas and 50% higher in very remote areas. There is no additional loading applied for supports in regional areas.

Providers should refer to support price limits based on where the support is delivered, which is not necessarily where the participant lives.

Temporary Transformation Payment (TTP)

Providers of attendant care and community participation supports who meet the eligibility criteria will have access to a higher price limit through a Temporary Transformation Payment, (TTP). This conditional loading will assist providers to continue to transform the businesses in the move towards a more competitive marketplace.

The support items available for TTP can be identified in the price guide with a T at the end of the Support Reference Number.
